International Summer School on Social Entrepreneurship

The first edition of the Summer School brought social entrepreneurs from domains such as health, livelihood, micro-finance, agriculture and energy. Faculty from IIT Madras engaged with the participants on variety of topics from 'Theories of Social Entrepreneurship' to' Business Model' and 'Design thinking'. This was interspersed with field visits to local social enterprises in Chennai and other parts of Tamil Nadu. The course helped the participants to gain a good understanding of the current trends and challenges in the social entrepreneurship ecosystem

Capacity Building Program for POPIs

In a mission to enhance the capacities of farmer producer organisations (FPOs), CSIE has organized a capacity building program for the promoting Institutions of such FPOs,termed Producer Organizations' Promoting Institutions (POPIs) from 9 - 11 October 2017 at IIT Madras. The first 2 days were organized as classroom sessions covering topics on 'Management', 'Futures Trading', 'Branding', 'Compliance', 'Nutritional aspects and 'Design-Thinking'. A panel discussion with key stakeholders from various relevant domains on day 2 and an exposure visit to a efficiently functioning FPO in Villupuram on the final day made this 3 day program complete. Another attraction of the program was the exhibition cum sale of the FPO products which attracted a huge crowd comprising mainly of the campus residents and IIT staff. Each stall had a turnover in the range of Rs.12,000 to Rs.48,000.


